Subject: Financial, Medical and Humanitarian aid to Ukraine.

GEC is a local Columbus, Ohio church. Grace Evangelical Church members consist of Slavic, but mostly Ukrainian people. As the need for aid for the Ukrainian people has arisen, we have taken the urgent initiative to help our people. The war for the independence of our country may be overseas, but its not far from our hearts. As our family and friends live under the constant threat of losing their lives, they continue to help those in need. We refuse to remain idle and so we reach out to anyone that may be able to help us.

As of now we have two routes to deliver aid overseas. The first is the most urgent and necessary supplies such as medical aid. These get packaged into containers and transported to New Jersey to be flown overseas. The cost of flying the content of one container into Poland is \$30,000. From there the goods are put on a truck and transported into Ukraine to one of two cities. Humanitarian and church organizations in Rivne and Lutsk deliver the aid where it is most needed including the front lines, bombed cities and hospitals. The victims of war depend on the support of the world coming together to stand against the evil and injustice that it forces on them. We are incredibly grateful for any donation of medical supplies as they help save countless lives dealt this injustice.

The second effort we have organized is the gathering of food, hygiene and clothes donations. These items are also packaged into containers, transported to Cleveland by truck and then to a port city by train. Next, they are put on a cargo ship and shipped to Europe for \$5000 per container. Then they are transported across Europe into Ukraine to the same two cities of Rivne and Lutsk. There the aid is again provided to those that need it most including those on the front lines and fleeing refugees.

The cost of transportation in each of these cases is fully financed by donations and our church. Medical aid is given priority to reach these areas and many risk their lives by driving into danger. Many have lost their lives doing so, but they are not forgotten and the love of God for those that are suffering shine through these martyrs. Any donations and aid would be immensely appreciated as God knows how much they are needed in this time. We are knocking on every door and reaching out to anyone willing to help. Thank you for standing with us. God bless you. God bless Ukraine.
